1. Prevention- planning & zoning, open space preservation, land development regulations, building codes, storm water management, fire fuel reduction, soil erosion and sediment control

- **Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP)**- planning, training, exercises
- **Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP)**- protection for railway infrastructure
- **Port Security Grant Program (PSGP)**- protection for critical ports infrastructure
- **Buffer Zone Protection Program (BZPP)**- planning and equipment to increase preparedness at chemical and nuclear facilities
- **Emergency Management Performance Grants (EMPG)**- to enhance government emergency management capabilities
- **Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program (IECGP)**- to improve interoperable emergency communications
- **Firewise Communities**- resources for planning & public education about wildfire

2. Property Protection- acquisition, relocation, storm shutters, rebuilding, barriers, flood-proofing, wind and earthquake structural retrofiting

- **Hazard Mitigation Grant program (HMGP)**- acquisition, relocation, elevation, structural retrofit, dry flood-proofing, local flood reduction, safe rooms, storm shutters, wildfire mitigation
- **Pre-Disaster Mitigation Program (PDM)**- acquisition, elevation, structural retrofit, safe rooms, drainage projects, vegetation management, storm water management projects, localized flood reduction projects, planning grants, some wildfire mitigation
- **Flood Mitigation Assistance Program (FMA)**- acquisition, relocation, elevation, dry flood-proofing, localized flood reduction projects
- **Repetitive Flood Claims Program (RFC) & Severe Repetitive Loss Program (SRL)**- acquisition, relocation, elevation, dry flood-proofing, localized flood control
- **Community Development Block Grants (CDBG)**- these funds can be "re-programmed" after disaster to be used as match for acquisition, relocation, and certain structural repair projects
- **Historic Preservation Fund Grants-in-Aid Program**- planning, education and some restoration (including mitigation measures) for historic properties

3. Public Education & Awareness- outreach projects, real estate disclosures, hazard information centers, technical assistance, school-aged and adult education programs
